COVID Safety Information

In preparation for NACUC's Chairman's Roundtable Forum, October 13-16 in Denver, we wanted to provide the following COVID safety information. Based on the current public health guidance at the federal and state levels, we are planning to move forward with an in-person event.

First, we are frequently monitoring the overall COVID status in Denver. Denver County is currently at the Green/Blue level (low-lowest risk). You may check the current status by visiting the [State of Colorado's COVID-19 page](#).

The Brown Palace, a Marriott Global property, has received [5-Star Certification](#). This rigorous and thorough certification process encourages businesses to implement safety measures beyond what is already required by state health agencies. With this certification, the hotel is now able to operate one level ahead of the current level that the county falls under. Denver County is currently operating in Green/Blue Level which means the Brown Palace is operating at the Green Level (lowest risk).
